## 349.11 \* Ordinance to lower speed limit on town highways.

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Springdale, Dane County

The Town Board of the Town of Springdale, Dane County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective June 22, 2017, speed limits on certain Town of Springdale town highways are reduced or modified as follows: Malone Road from Lewis Road to State Highway 92 (1500') reduced from 55 MPH to 45 MPH.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.\*
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted town highways in violation of the above noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats. This ordinance is effective on June 22, 2017.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
